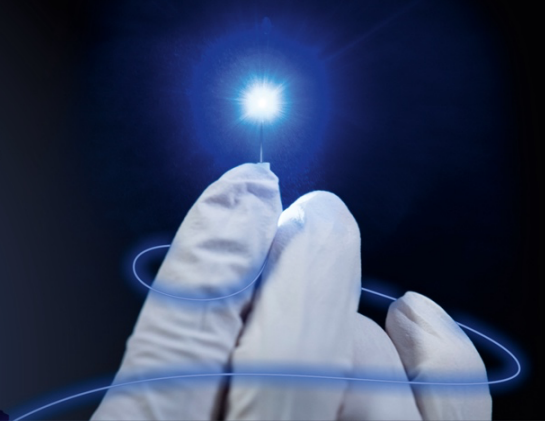

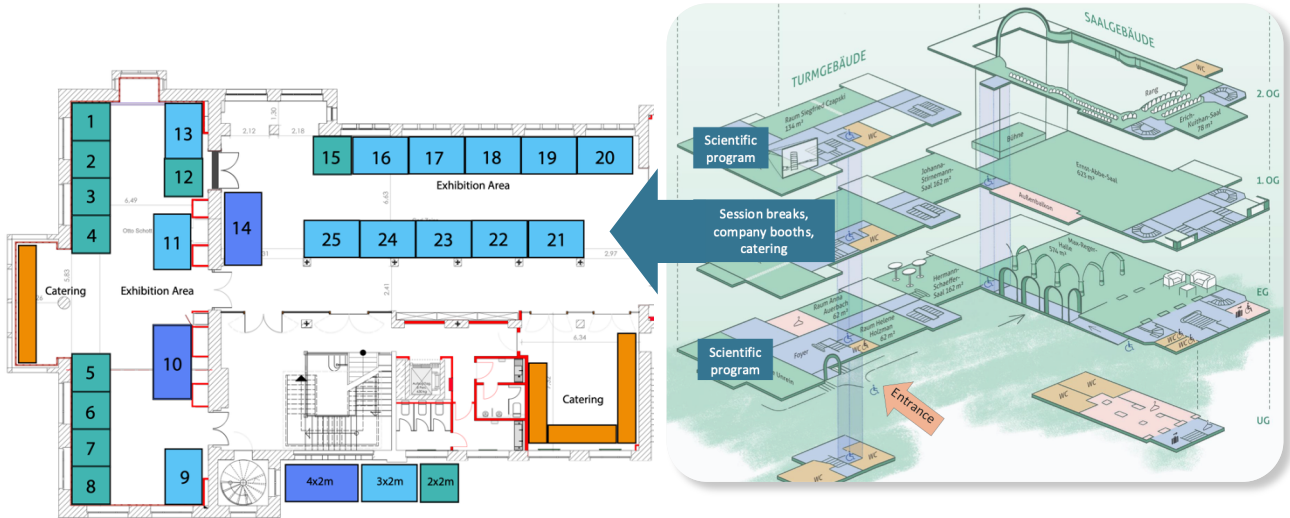
The Volkshaus Jena is one of the city's most iconic public buildings and traces its origins to an initiative by the physicist and social reformer Ernst Abbe. As early as 1902, the planned building was celebrated as the "Volkspalast" (People's Palace), before it was opened to the public on November 1, 1903, following a short construction period. Together with Siegfried Czapski, Abbe brought to life the idea of an open house that was intentionally intended to be accessible to all social groups.

From the very beginning, the Volkshaus served not only cultural purposes but also as a central venue for lectures, scientific conferences, and gatherings within the university and industrial communities.

After 1990 the Volkshaus was gradually renovated and modernized. A comprehensive renovation finally began in 2019, with the goal of developing the building into a contemporary conference and event center. Today, the Volkshaus Jena symbolizes the fusion of tradition and modernity and has established itself as a premier venue for conferences, academic meetings, and professional exchanges.



ROOM CONCEPT

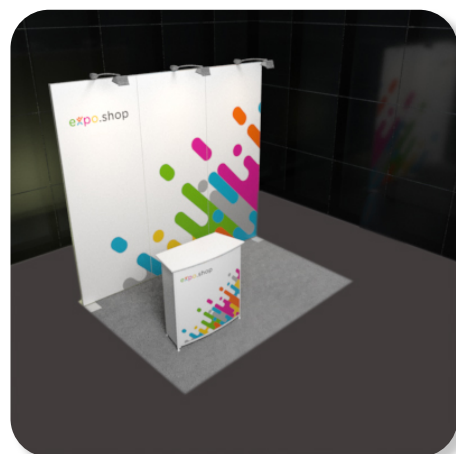
