TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General – Scope

- (1) These Terms of Service apply to contracts between Leibniz IPHT as the organizer of WSOF 2027 and possible sponsors or exhibitors, hereinafter referred to as customers.
- (2) The Terms of Service of the Leibniz IPHT apply exclusively; Leibniz IPHT does not recognise the customer's terms and conditions that conflict with or deviate from the Terms of Service, unless it has expressly agreed to their validity in writing. The Terms of Service of Leibniz IPHT shall also apply if Leibniz IPHT performs the service without reservation in knowledge of the customer's terms and conditions that conflict with or deviate from its Terms of Service.
- (3) All agreements made between Leibniz IPHT and the customer for the purpose of performing the service are set out in these Terms of Service. Ancillary agreements must be made and signed by a written instrument in order to be effective or in the electronic form in accordance with Art. 26 of Regulation (EU) No. 910/2014 (eIDAS Regulation, advanced electronic signature). This also applies to a deviation from this formal requirement.
- (4) The Terms of Service of the Leibniz IPHT apply exclusively to companies or legal entities under public law or special funds under public law within the meaning of Section 310 (1) of the German Civil Code.

Scope of services of the Leibniz IPHT

- (1) The scope of services depends on the specific sponsorship or exhibitor packages booked.
- (2) Leibniz IPHT does not owe any transport of the customer's exhibits to or from the exhibition venue.
- (3) A security service will not be provided by Leibniz IPHT at the event.

Remuneration – Terms of Payment

- (1) VAT is not included in the agreed remuneration; it is shown separately in the invoice at the statutory rate on the day of invoicing.
- (2) The deduction of cash discount is excluded.
- (3) Unless otherwise agreed, the remuneration is due for payment within 14 days from the date of invoice. The legal rules regarding the consequences of late payment apply.
- (4) The customer is only entitled to rights of set-off if his counterclaims have been legally established, undisputed or recognized by the Leibniz IPHT. In addition, the customer is entitled to exercise a right of retention to the extent that **his counterclaim is based on the same contractual relationship**.

Cancellations and changes by the customer/No show

Any cancellations, space reductions or changes made by the customer regarding their booked sponsorship or exhibitor package are subject to the following conditions:

- More than 10 weeks before the start of the conference: Entitled to a full refund
- Less than 10 weeks before the start of the conference: No refund

Liability

- (1) Leibniz IPHT shall be liable in accordance with the statutory provisions if the customer asserts claims for damages based on intent or gross negligence, including intent or gross negligence on the part of its representatives or vicarious agents. With the exception of claims based on intent, liability for damages is limited to the foreseeable, typically occurring damage.
- (2) Leibniz IPHT is liable in accordance with the statutory provisions if it culpably violates an essential contractual obligation; in this case, however, liability for damages is also limited to the foreseeable, typically occurring damage. An essential contractual obligation is one that forms the basis of the contract, was decisive for its conclusion, and upon the fulfillment of which the customer could reasonably rely on.
- (3) Liability for culpable injury to life, limb or health remains unaffected.
- (4) Unless otherwise stipulated above, liability of Leibniz IPHT is excluded.

Rights of use

The customer grants Leibniz IPHT a perpetual, non-exclusive license to use the customer's logo on promotional materials, in the context of WSOF 2027 and on the event website.

Place of jurisdiction – choice of law – place of performance

- (1) If the customer is a merchant, a legal entity under public law or a special fund under public law, the place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising from this contract is the registered office of Leibniz IPHT.
- (2) The law of the Federal Republic of Germany applies exclusively.
- (3) Unless otherwise agreed, the place of performance is the registered office of Leibniz IPHT.
